- 1. Sale of Admission form: 5<sup>th</sup> to 15<sup>th</sup> April 2021 on school working days from 9:00 AM to 12:00 Noon
- 2. Registration/Submission of duly filled Admission till 16<sup>th</sup> April from 9:30 AM to 1:00 PM.
- 3. The date of admission test/ screening /selection of students to be notified on later date.
- 4. CRITERIA FOR ADMISSION:
  - (a) For admission to LKG the child must be more than 3 years and 6 months, but less than 4 years of age as on 1<sup>st</sup> April' 2021.
  - (b) Overall growth, personal hygiene, self-care, age of the student are the main criteria for admission in LKG and Std. I.
- 5. Documents/Papers to be submitted with Admission Form at the time of registration:
  - (a) Self-attested copy of birth certificate issued by Municipality/Block.
  - (b) Self-attested copy of caste certificate if belonging to SC/ST/OBC.
  - (c) Self-attested copy of identity address proof.
  - (d) Self-attested copy of Aadhar Card.
  - (e) Samagra ID generated by the MP Government.
  - (f) 02 Coloured passport size photographs.
  - (g) Blood group certificate of the student.
  - (h) Copy of the first page of bank account passbook.

## **NOTE:**

- a) Registration/filling of admission form must not be treated as a guarantee for the admission in the class.
- b) Registration slip has to be obtained from the office by the parents at the time of registration of the students.
- c) Both parent's i.e. father and mother should accompany their child at the time of screening. This is to make the students comfortable in the new environment.
- d) Age mentioned in the admission form shall also be determined on the basis of physical verification of age.
- e) Ward of NMDC, DAV, CISF employees & nearby villages will be given preference in the admission.
- f) 25% of total seats are available for admission in LKG for those who are belonging to BPL categories. This is strictly done as per the directives of the state government.
